Imagine you work on a tea estate which has just received **£1000** in Fairtrade Premium.

1 nurse £200

1 doctor £400

1 teacher £200

Scholarship for one child to attend secondary school £10

Iron roofing to replace thatched roofs for better rain protection £20 per house

Health clinic £700

Bike £10

Maize £50 per village

Malaria nets £5 per family

***Do you think one thing is more important than another?***

***How will you make sure that your voice gets heard?***

***How will you all come to an agreement?***
